Riga is the capital of Latvia. It is the largest city of the Baltic states and home to one third of Latvia's population. The climate of Riga is humid continental. The coldest months are January and February. The summers in Riga are warm and humid with the average temperature of 18°C, while the temperature on hottest days can exceed 30°C.

- More than 40 percent of Latvia's territory is covered by forests. Latvia has beautiful nature and at the annual Midsummer celebration locals like to look for a mystical flower of love "Papardes zieds"..

BY PLANE

Riga International Airport (RIX) [in Latvian: Starptautiska Rigas Lidosta] Airport is located 10 km southwest from Riga center.

- Flybus (from Riga, Kaunas and Vilnus)

BY TRAIN



Latvian Railways connects many Latvian cities as well as few countries outside Latvia, such as Russia, Belarus and Estonia.

BY FERRY Tallink operates daily Ferry service between Stockholm and Riga. Prices start from 28 EUR.





FYI

You can travel to Lithuania or Estonia by plane (so keep an eye for plane tickets to Kaunas, Tallin or Vilnus) as the flights often are much cheaper to these countries. If you fly to Estonia or Lithuania first it is easy to get BUS tickets to Riga. – ECOLINES bus (starts from 5 EUR one way)

MUST-HAVES and THINGS TO KNOW

WHAT TO BRING Check-list:



- ✓ Your passport or ID;
 - ✓ ISIC Card or Student ID;
 - Medical and travel insurance;
 - Medication (if you need anything special);
 - ✓ Warm sweater (it can get cold in summer too);
 - ✓ Summer hat and sunscreen;
 - Extra money and course fee in cash;
 - For International Evening you country's traditional food and drinks and your country's flag or other traditional decorations (could be big or small);
 - Swimsuit, slippers;
 - ✓ Water-proof jacket or rain-coat;
 - Toiletries (towel, hygene items);
 - Backpack for easier walking.

PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION

Option 1: We suggest to choose a Yellow e-ticket for certain number of trips:

- It can be bought in ticket vending machines, trade outlets of "Rigas Satiksme" and it is convenient for

- passangers who do not use Riga public transport on a regular basis, including guests;
- Tickets have to be used within 12 months upon the moment of purchace.

Price 1,15 EUR per 1 trip

Option 2: Paper ticket sold in public transport and in night transport only that is valid for the trip during which it has been bought.

Price 2,- EUR per 1 trip



When entering public transport – bus, trolleybus or tram, a passenger has to apply a yellow or a blue e-ticket to an electronic validator. Electronic validators are located in public transport vehicles – buses, trolleybuses and trams and register passengers paying for the trip. When entering public transport, a passenger has to apply an e-ticket to an electronic validator. If you decide to take the risk and drive without ticket, you should know that the penalty is 20,- EUR.
